
SCHOOL AGE LEVEL






Welcome to the **Kidney Health Clinic**! You are here to get your **kidneys** checked.




The first step:


You go to the desk and the **Clerk** will check your information.








The Nurse will put the **blood pressure cuff** around your arm.






The Nurse will check your **medicines** and ask you and your Mom or Dad some questions.







After the Nurse asks you questions, the **Doctor** will come in and check you.





The Doctor will talk to you and your Mom and Dad about keeping your kidneys healthy. The Doctor will give your Mom and Dad a **prescription** and instructions.

ADOLESCENT LEVEL



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I have some trouble with my **kidneys** so I'm going to the **Kidney Health Clinic**.

The Kidney Health Clinic is the place to be. You will meet your **Kidney Health Team**. Their job is to work with you to keep your kidneys as healthy as possible. You will be learning how to look after your kidneys.








When you come to the Kidney Health Clinic, you need to check in.

After I take off my shoes, a **Clerk** or a **Nurse** will check my **height** and **weight**.





The Nurse will take you into a room. Then the Nurse will check your **medicines** and **blood pressure**.



Do we have everything we need for clinic?

We do, including our bag of medicines. I've got my original pill bottles and my **pill organizer**. Let's go!





The Nurse checks my blood pressure.
The Nurse puts the **cuff** around my arm. The cuff gets tight and then loose again.

It's important to sit quietly during this test.



Hmmm, I might start keeping notes on my phone or in a little notebook so I can tell the Nurse or someone else on the Kidney Health Team how I have been feeling.

That's a great idea. It can be hard to remember everything when you get to the clinic. Of course, my parents are there to help too!



The Nurse will take a few minutes to talk to you. They will ask lots of questions about how you are feeling and if you are having any trouble with your medicines or anything else.



Next up will be the **Doctor**. The Doctor will talk to you about your kidney health and also examine your body.

That makes sense. What if I feel uncomfortable talking about my body with the Doctor?

No problem. You can just ask for somebody to come in the room with you.



Then the Doctor will give me a **prescription**?

Yes! Take care of your prescription until you can give it to your **Pharmacist**.





A **prescription** is a paper with the names of medicines you need for your kidney health. One of the Kidney Health Team members will go over the instructions for taking the medicines with you and your parents.

So what happens next at Kidney Health Clinic? There are lots of people on the team. There might be teaching or someone else from the Kidney Health Team might talk to you before you go.

I'd like to talk to you about eating.

How is school going? How are you feeling about things?

Let's chat about how to keep healthy!











How do I find out who is on my Kidney Health Team?

There are photos so you can learn who they are.



Remember, it's **YOUR** team so if you want to speak to any member of the team without your parents, that's ok.

As you get older your Kidney Health Team will ask to speak to you alone for part of the check-up too.
